



The Urban Renewal Authority (“URA”) is tasked to undertake urban renewal in accordance with the provisions of the Urban Renewal Authority Ordinance and the Urban Renewal Strategy published by the Government. The URA adopts a holistic approach to urban renewal with redevelopment and rehabilitation as its core businesses.

Senior Manager/ Manager, Sustainability (Ref. SM/M(S))

Responsibilities: The job holder will assist in developing and implementing environmental strategies and action plans that ensure corporate sustainable development; take the lead on sustainable procurement for all goods and services; coordinate all aspects related to environment, conservation and energy savings; lead the implementation of environmental policies and practices; ensure compliance with environmental legislation; audit, analyse and report environmental performance to internal and related external parties; lead, manage or carry out impact assessments to identify, assess and reduce the Authority’s environmental risks and financial costs; promote and raise awareness, at all levels, of the impact of emerging environmental issues, whether legislative or best practice, on corporate, ethical and social responsibility; manage the development, continual improvement and implementation of the Authority’s environmental policy and management system; develop with appropriate input from consultants the Authority’s environmental and sustainability initiatives/ implementations in the Authority’s projects; write environmental reports, lead, manage or carry out of carbon and energy audits and train up staff at all levels in environmental issues and responsibilities.

Requirements: The suitable candidate should be a degree holder in environmental management, engineering or related disciplines, with relevant environmental related or other equivalent professional qualifications, plus a minimum of 15 years’ experience in sustainability/ environmental design and management with at least 12 years’ post qualification experience and at least 5 years in a senior management capacity. He/she should also be a good communicator and possess good knowledge of relevant Hong Kong and related environmental practice and laws. Applicant with less experience may be considered for the post of Manager, Sustainability.
