 - a) Comprehensive baseline review on physical attributes (including but not limited to building data, building conditions, age, ownership pattern, etc.) and the demographic and socio-economic characteristics
 - b) Identify key issues, opportunities and constraints arising from the baseline review;
 - c) Development of planning strategies and preparation of Master Plan with different resources scenarios, embracing other smart initiatives and place-making strategies;
 - d) Implementation of project covering different mode of urban renewal strategies including Redevelopment, Rehabilitation, Preservation and Revitalization, and restructuring & re-planning;
 - e) Financial appraisals/assessments to the recommended implementation programmes and mechanisms; and
 - f) Preparation of notional architectural and urban design schemes for the Master Plan.
