1 Lok Hau Fook Restaurant

📍 1-3 Hau Wong Road

Time-honored Chiuchow restaurant, serving as a filming location for numerous movies

2 Cheong Thai Supermarket

📍 430-432 Prince Edward Road West

Offering traditional Thai food, condiments, and snacks

3 Mini Bangkok Thai Food

📍 9-11 Nam Kok Road

Train-themed restaurant specializing in Thai shrimp sashimi and tom yum soup

4 Chiu Chow Hop Shing Dessert

📍 9 Lung Kong Road

Chiuchow dessert shop with almost 70 years of tradition

5 Golden Orchid Thai Restaurant

📍 10-12 Lung Kong Road

Led by Thai chefs, offering a diverse range of Thai dishes

6 Thonglor

📍 19 Lung Kong Road

A modern Thai restaurant with authentic Thai street food

7 金泰沙冰(Chinese Only)

📍 21 Nga Tsin Wai Road

Paired with Hong Kong-style and Thai sauces, night market-style Thai barbecue

8 Pomelo

📍 17-19 Nga Tsin Wai Road

Thai grocery store selling special dried goods

9 彩虹 (Chinese Only)

📍 20C South Wall Road

Renowned pandan coconut custard buns delivered daily from Thailand

10 Wong Chun Chun Thai Restaurant

📍 23 Tak Ku Ling Road

A 40-year-old establishment specializing in Thai-style stir-fry dishes

11 Chong Fat Chiu Chow Restaurant

📍 60-62 South Wall Road

Founded in Chaozhou, a popular dining spot for celebrities

12 Kwai Yue Cake Shop Limited

📍 59 South Wall Road

Selling traditional Chaozhou pastries like white-skin mung bean cakes and mooncakes

13 恆發中式食品 (Chinese Only)

📍 55 Carpenter Road

Selling various traditional Chinese foods

14 潮發白米雜貨 (Chinese Only)

📍 46 Nga Tsin Long Road

Chiuchow grocery store founded in 1949, selling specialties like kueh and sea melon seeds

Kowloon City Wonders

15 Tak Hing Fish Ball Company

📍 76 Fuk Lo Tsun Road

Handmade fish balls originating from Kowloon Walled City, loved by locals

16 豐記洋酒公司 (Chinese Only)

📍 20 South Wall Road

Transformed from a liquor shop into a tea house offering various tea cakes and tea products

17 松海號士多雜貨 (Chinese Only)

📍 17 Tak Ku Ling Road

Long-standing neighborhood store selling groceries

18 Royal Dessert

📍 15 South Wall Road

A popular dessert shop offering varieties of Chinese, Western creative desserts

19 Islam Food

📍 15 South Wall Road

Halal certified, selling over a thousand signature beef patties daily

20 Wong Ming Kee

📍 40-42 Sa Po Road

Over 40 years in business, known for popular handmade pork and cuttlefish balls

21 Chan Ming Kee

📍 77 Kai Tak Road

Dedicated to preserving traditional Chinese homemade noodle-making techniques

22 金城海味 (Chinese Only)

📍 44 Nga Tsin Long Road

Operating for over 60 years, offering premium abalone, fish maw, and more

Heritage Footprints

23 Head Office of The Lok Sin Tong Benevolent Society, Kowloon

📍 61 Lung Kong Road

Founded during the Qing Dynasty (1880), offering medical care, education and social welfare services

24 Remnants of the South Gate of Kowloon Walled City (Declared Monument)

📍 Kowloon Walled City Park

Built in the Qing Dynasty, demolished during WWII, and preserved at its original site after 1990s archaeological work

25 Former Yamen Building of Kowloon Walled City (Declared Monument)

📍 Kowloon Walled City Park

Built in the Qing Dynasty, preserved and restored during the clearance of the Kowloon Walled City

26 Hau Wong Temple (Declared Monument)

📍 130 Junction Road

The only temple in Kowloon dedicated to Hau Wong, housing rich collection of historical relics of the Walled City

27 Stonehouses Family Garden (Grade III historic buildings)

📍 133 Junction Road

A row of Chinese residences built after WWII, the last remnants of Hau Wong Temple New Village

📍 Junction of Lung Kong Road and Prince Edward Road West

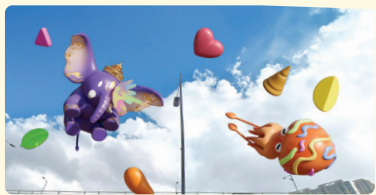
Activated by AR, relive the sight of planes flying low over rooftops

📍 Junction of Tak Ku Ling Road and Prince Edward Road West

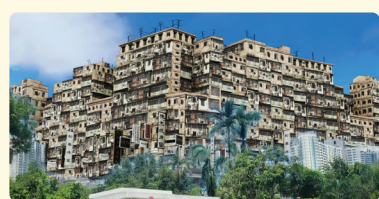
A fantastical aerial encounter with Chiuchow braised squid and Thai flying elephant

A tense standoff between triad members in the restaurant

36 Twilight of the Warriors: Walled In (2024)

📍 Lok Hau Fook Restaurant: 1-3 Hau Wong Road

Hosting a festive banquet, Mr. Chau is unaware that his enemy' s son is among the guests

37 PTU (2003)

📍 Fong Wing Kee: 85-87 Hau Wong Road

Sergeant, triad leader, and the assassin sit around hotpots, appearing calm but hiding own agendas

Dr. Lam' s Chinese medicine shop also is a place for exorcising evil
